Comandos

Para crear un usuario en MariaDB por comandos hay que acceder a él.

```
yoda@elvigilante:~$ sudo mysql -u root -p

Le damos permisos totales o los que queremos en mi caso todos y recargamos la tabla de privilegios.

MariaDB [(none)]> flush privileges;
